
#### **Deck without Clearance Relief - Feasibility Study**







# **Transportation Strategy: Interior Streets** Curb-less streets, 5-10 mph Emergency & limited service vehicle access at all times Flexible space along street edge for: drop-off & pick-up, loading, parklets, bikes, and Micro-mobility infrastructure In the future: No vehicular access; AV's, Micro-mobility, and emergency vehicles only Structural Deck Rails below




# We developed 3 open space strategies based on feedback from stakeholder engagement sessions.

#### **Open Space Goals**








#### **Destination Park**

- Large-scale open space (approx 7+ acres)
- Mixed active recreation and passive recreation
- Playgrounds
- Attracts visitors from the surrounding neighborhoods









#### Neighborhood Park

- Mid-scale open space
- Attracts nearby residents and visitors on a daily basis
- Combines passive recreation and small scale park activities

#### Pocket Park

- Small-scale open space
- Unique moments of respite or play within the city grid








#### Connector Park

- Connects across continued blocks and neighborhoods




